Small Delegation Application Instructions

For small delegations, that have 8 or fewer students, please follow the following instructions on how to apply to HMUN 2018.

1. In the right-hand column of our website, www.harvardmun.org, there will be a link to apply for HMUN 2018.
2. Click on this link, which will redirect you to our database at munbase.harvardmun.org. If you are accepted, you will also return to MUNbase over the next few months to access and update your application information.
3. Enter your e-mail address and a secure password in order to create a new MUNbase account. You may need to create an account on an annual basis.
4. On the next page, please fill in the name of your school, the name and contact information of the Faculty Advisor, and the mailing address for the school. You will also be able to add additional Faculty Advisors to your account later, if necessary. The Faculty Advisor listed in this page will be the assumed, primary contact for application status and conference updates.
5. Click Save and Continue, and then follow the prompts on the following pages. Enter information about your delegation size: the expected number of delegates and the expected number of Faculty Advisors. If you have a small delegation you may apply for an ECOSOC delegation and follow steps 6-7. If you do not have the minimum number of students for an ECOSOC country assignment, it is recommended that you encourage your students to apply for conference via the Individual Application process. If this applies, please see Application Instructions for the Individual Application.
6. Enter country preferences. You must enter all ten preferences for ECOSOC in order to apply. You may find the country assignment list on our website that lists the appropriate maximum number for each country assignment.
7. Explain your preferences. Why did you rank these countries? What factors are most important to you in country assignments? For example, which is more important to you, the country assigned, or the number of delegates that you have requested? Is there a type of country or region of the world in which you are especially interested? You will also be asked to tell us about your delegation's model United Nations program and experience.
8. Finally, you will have a chance to review your application. Check that all of your answers are satisfactory, and be sure to carefully read HMUN's Terms & Conditions. Please note that upon submission, you will no longer be able to edit your application. Click the box at the bottom to submit!
9. After submitting your application, you will receive a confirmation e-mail. Schools accepted to Harvard Model United Nations 2018 will be notified soon afterward.
